- further lab tour(s) with focus an nanometrology

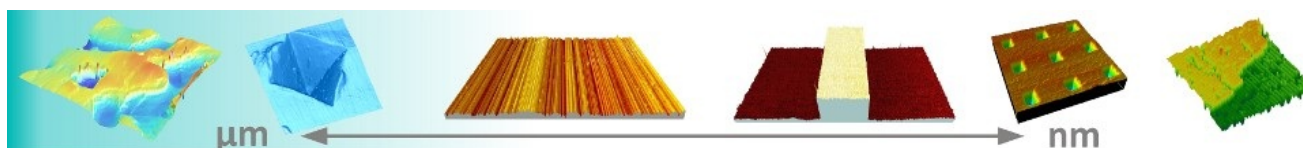
>> Registration lists will be available at the check-in and during the conference. Please sign it if you are interested.
